

After Less Than a Year in NoMad, Barstool Sports Doubling Offices to 12K SF

Sports news and information website <u>Barstool Sports</u> has signed a 5,909-square-foot lease to expand its presence at <u>The Kaufman Organization</u>'s <u>15 West 27th Street</u> to about 11,800 square feet, Commercial Observer has learned.

The company inked a five-deal for the entire second floor of the 11-story building between Broadway and Fifth Avenue, according to information provided by the landlord. The asking rent for the new space was in the mid-\$60s per square foot. The news website did not have a broker in the transaction.

Barstool Sports is expanding its offices within just a year of moving into the building. The company signed <u>a lease</u> for the 5,909 square feet, or the entire third floor, in April 2016, as CO previously reported.

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Kaufman is currently designing the new addition for Barstool Sports with an expected March move-in. The space features large windows facing West 27th Street.

"We are excited that Barstool Sports is continuing to grow at [15 West 27th Street], as they are the ideal tenant for our loft-style spaces and bring a youthful and fun vibe to the building," Kaufman's <u>Michael Heaner</u>, who represented the landlord in-house with colleagues <u>Grant Greenspan</u> and <u>Elliot Warren</u>, said in a prepared statement.

Barstool Sports left Massachusetts for New York City when it moved into 15 West 27th Street last summer. Its existing third-floor offices have a live-streaming newsroom.
